Rico Vannini received his doctorate from the University of Zurich in 1984 and specialized in small animal surgery for three years at Ohio State University in the USA. He worked for nine years as a senior physician and lecturer at the University of Zurich's small animal surgery clinic.

Together with his wife, he founded Bessy's Small Animal and Referral Clinic in Watt-Regensdorf in 1995, which soon became one of the largest small animal clinics in Switzerland. Twenty years later, he sold the clinic to IVC/Evidensia.

Rico Vannini was president of renowned international professional organizations (Working Group for Osteosynthesis AO-VET, European Society of Veterinary Orthopedics and Traumatology - ESVOT). Through his work as chairman and instructor at countless continuing education courses, as well as a speaker, author, and co-author of numerous publications and surgical textbooks, he has gained worldwide reputation in small animal surgery and orthopedics.

In recent years, he shifted his focus to canine sports medicine and orthopedics. The treatment and care of canine athletes soon became his new passion.

With his Border Collies, he can actively live out his enthusiasm for dog sports in agility – expertise and passion for the sport go hand in hand for him.
